Dorothy Day House Kitchen

Dorothy Day House prepares breakfast, lunch, and dinner out of our Center Street location, then transports and serves to participants in our 3 locations, as well as community members in need.

Volunteers work with a staff member to prep food, portion meals into containers, set up for service, serve meals, then clean up afterward.

Berkeley Community Resource Center

At the BCRC, we provide on average 50 showers a day, 8-10 loads of laundry per day, and storage locker services for 58 unhoused individuals to store their belongings. Our day program also includes breakfast and lunch. We actively engage with other community service agencies for Housing Solutions, Income, Employment, and Mental Health Services.

BCRC also offers access to a clothing closet that includes warm garments for both men and women. We receive generous clothing donations from the community, and there's work to be done!. We need volunteers to help manage the closet and create a welcoming environment for folks to choose what they need. This includes sorting, organizing and laundering donations, as well as assisting BCRC staff as needs arise.

Volunteer opportunities

- Breakfast - 2 shifts per day, Monday through Saturday
- Lunch - 2 shifts, every day
- Dinner - 1 shift, every day
- Clothing Closet - 1 shift, Mon/Wed/Fri
